Along with regular issues of payment, forms and waivers, several Issues happened outside the post control. Poor Communication between State level and the post 1, Location Change not communicated and no one available to reroute the buses, Pick Up different from drop off location was not comunicated to post so boys had to spend additional hour in the sun. A bar showing where they were in completing application process showed 20% no matter where they were at in the application process. An option was added to the post approval page to link individual boys to the post. The County required all boys to fill out and submit a county bus waiver.
